

Kyle's Hat



Bringing Quality Yarn from Ewe to You!

The ribbing on the hat makes it stretchy. The wide brim adds extra warmth over the ears. And the decreases make it really cool.



Size: Youth large/Adult small (Adult large)

Instructions

Cast on 90 (108) stitches. Join in the round being careful not to twist. Place marker for beginning of round. Work in k4, p2 ribbing for 3".

Fold line: remove stitch marker. Wrap and turn first stitch. Flip work inside out. Purl 2, replace stitch marker. Work in k4, p2 ribbing for 6 (7)" more. (On the first round after flipping it inside out, you'll be knitting the purls and purling the knits.) [9 (10)" from CO edge.]

Decrease:

Set up row: *(k4, p2) 3x, place marker* repeat to end of round. You should have 5 (6) decrease sections. Decrease every row as follows: *work in pattern to two stitches before marker, p2tog* repeat to end of round. Continue decreasing until 10 (12) stitches remain. Change from circular to double pointed needles as needed.

Last row: *k2tog* to end. 5 (6) stitches remain. Cut yarn. Using darning needle, draw up remaining stitches and pull to close. Weave in ends.

Materials

Monte Donegal – 2 skeins OR
Misti Maki – 2 skeins, or about 220 yards
worsted weight yarn
US 5 16" circular needles
US 5 double pointed needles
Darning Needle
Stitch Marker

Stitches:

CO- cast on
BO- bind off
K-knit
K2tog- knit two stitches together
P2tog- purl two stitches together
P- purl
