

Shifting Colors

Materials:

Boboli Lace – One Ball (MC)

Andean Mist – Three coordinating colors, one ball each (CC)

Needles

16" size US 9 Circular needles

Stitch Marker

Tapestry Needle

For Optional Provisional Cast on:

A spare set of circular needles, size 9 or smaller, length not important

Crochet hook size g or h

Waste yarn for provisional cast on

Gauge

4.5 stitches per inch

Dimensions: 6.5" wide by 47" circumference

Cast on 56 stitches (either using the provisional cast on or a regular cast on).

Being careful not to twist, join to knit in the round.

You will be knitting every round using two strands held together, following the sequence below.

Knit 28 rounds with Boboli Lace & CC1

Knit 5 rounds with CC1 & CC2

Knit 28 rounds with Boboli Lace & CC2

Knit 5 rounds with CC2 and CC3

Knit 28 rounds with Boboli Lace & CC3

Knit 5 rounds with CC3 & CC1

Repeat these rounds a total of three times.

Finishing

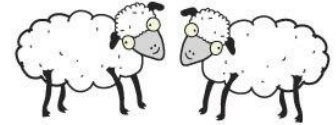
If you used a regular cast on: using tapestry needle, match the two ends of the tube together and stitch together.

If you used a provisional cast on: Remove waste yarn and place the live stitches on the extra needle, and join the two ends together using kitchener stitch.
