

# Stella's Cowl



## Instructions

Cast on 120 stitches, placing stitch markers every 15 stitches (if desired). Join to knit in the round and place a Beginning of Round marker. (Make sure it's different than the other markers. I found it very helpful to have it be a different size as well as a different color.)

## Garter Edge:

Row 1 (RS): \*kfb, k5, cdd, k5, kfb\* repeat to end of round.

Row 2: Purl

Row 3 (RS): \*kfb, k5, cdd, k5, kfb\* repeat to end of round.

Row 4: Purl

## Body of Cowl:

Row 1 (RS): \*kfb, k5, cdd, k5, kfb\* repeat to end of round.

Row 2: Knit

Repeat these two rows until you piece measures 9" from cast on, ending with row 2.

## Garter Edge:

Work 4 rows of Garter Edge as above.

Bind off loosely, weave in ends and block.

## Materials:

**Yarn:** 2 balls Adriafile Stella Jacq

**Needles:** 24" Size 7 Circular (or size needed to get gauge)

**Dimensions:** 22" around and 10" tall

**Gauge:** 4.5 stitches per inch in stockinet stitch

## Definitions

**K:** Knit

**P:** Purl

**KFB:** Knit in the front and the back of the same stitch

**CDD:** centered double decrease: Slip 2 stitches at the same time as to knit, knit the next stitch, pass the two slipped over at the same time (2 stitches decreased)
